V. DOI Update - John Hord

- Annual Reconciliation non-filers for 2019 and 2020:
 - o Companies: 257 in 2020 compared with 280 in 2019 as of this date.
 - o Brokers: 481 in 2020 vs. 956 in 2019 as of this date.
- DOI is preparing to re-test the verified risk location vendors for compliance with the accuracy standard.
- Filing of quarterly returns with local governments did not seem to be adversely affected by COVID-19.

• The vacant city government slot on the Council was filled by Joseph Ewald, Finance Director of the City of Fort Thomas.

VII. New Business

- Commissioner Clark discussed the impact in LGPT of guidance issued by DOI on personal auto and other items.
